

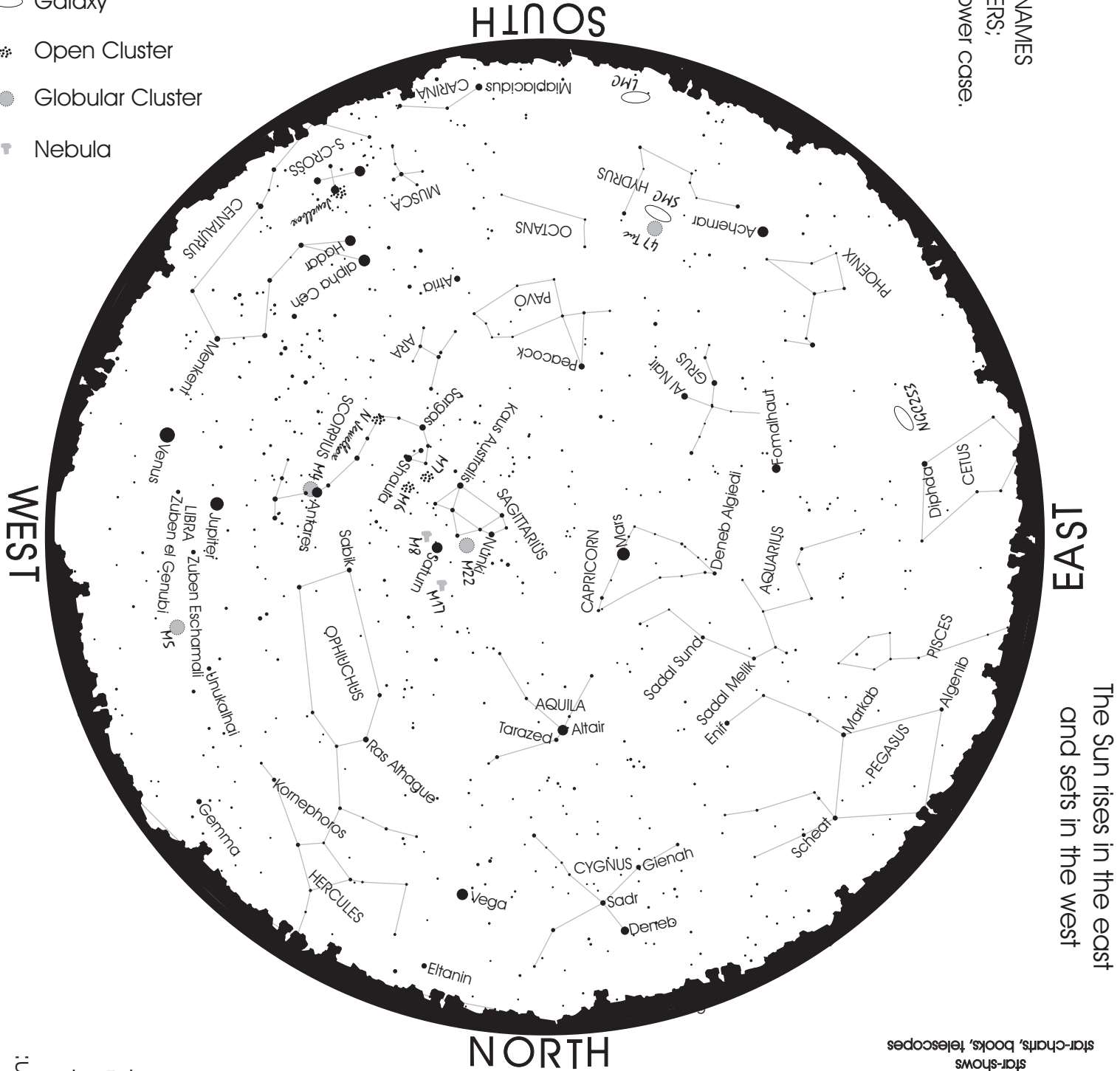
# THE SOUTH AFRICAN EARLY EVENING SKY LATE SEP / EARLY OCT 2018

To find e.g. stars in the east,  
face east and turn the map  
so that **EAST** is at the bottom.

CONSTELLATION NAMES  
ARE CAPITAL LETTERS;  
star names are lower case.

Use binoculars to look for ...

- Galaxy
- ✦ Open Cluster
- Globular Cluster
- ☄ Nebula

Oct 2<sup>nd</sup>: last quarter  
Oct 9<sup>th</sup>: new moon
