

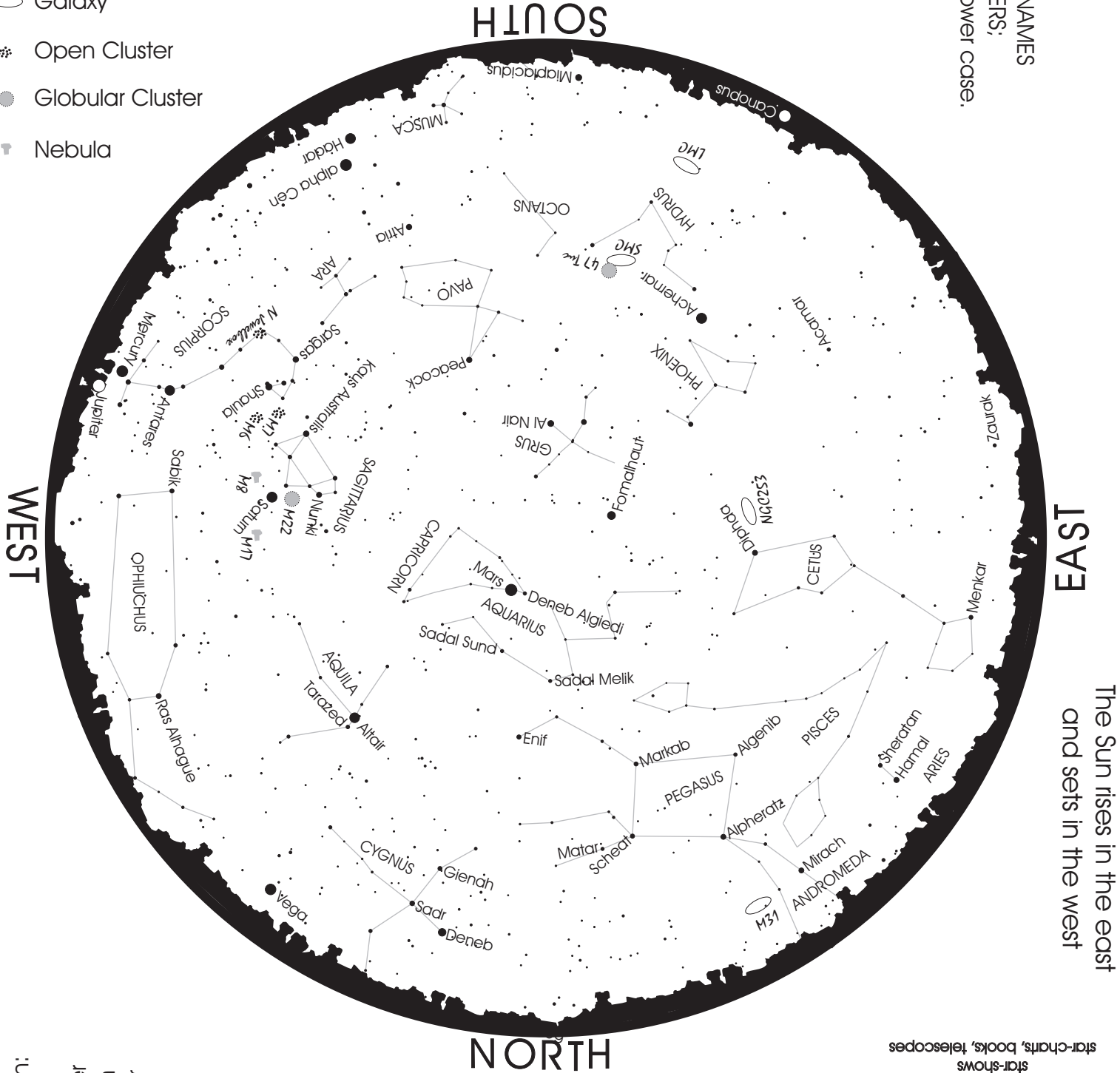
# THE SOUTH AFRICAN EARLY EVENING SKY LATE OCT / EARLY NOV 2018

To find e.g. stars in the east,  
face east and turn the map  
so that **EAST** is at the bottom.

CONSTELLATION NAMES  
ARE CAPITAL LETTERS;  
star names are lower case.

Use binoculars to look for ...

- Galaxy
- ✳ Open Cluster
- Globular Cluster
- † Nebula

and sets in the west

- The Moon this month:
- Oct 24<sup>th</sup>: full moon
- Oct 31<sup>st</sup>: last quarter
- Nov 7<sup>th</sup>: new moon
- Nov 15<sup>th</sup>: first quarter
