

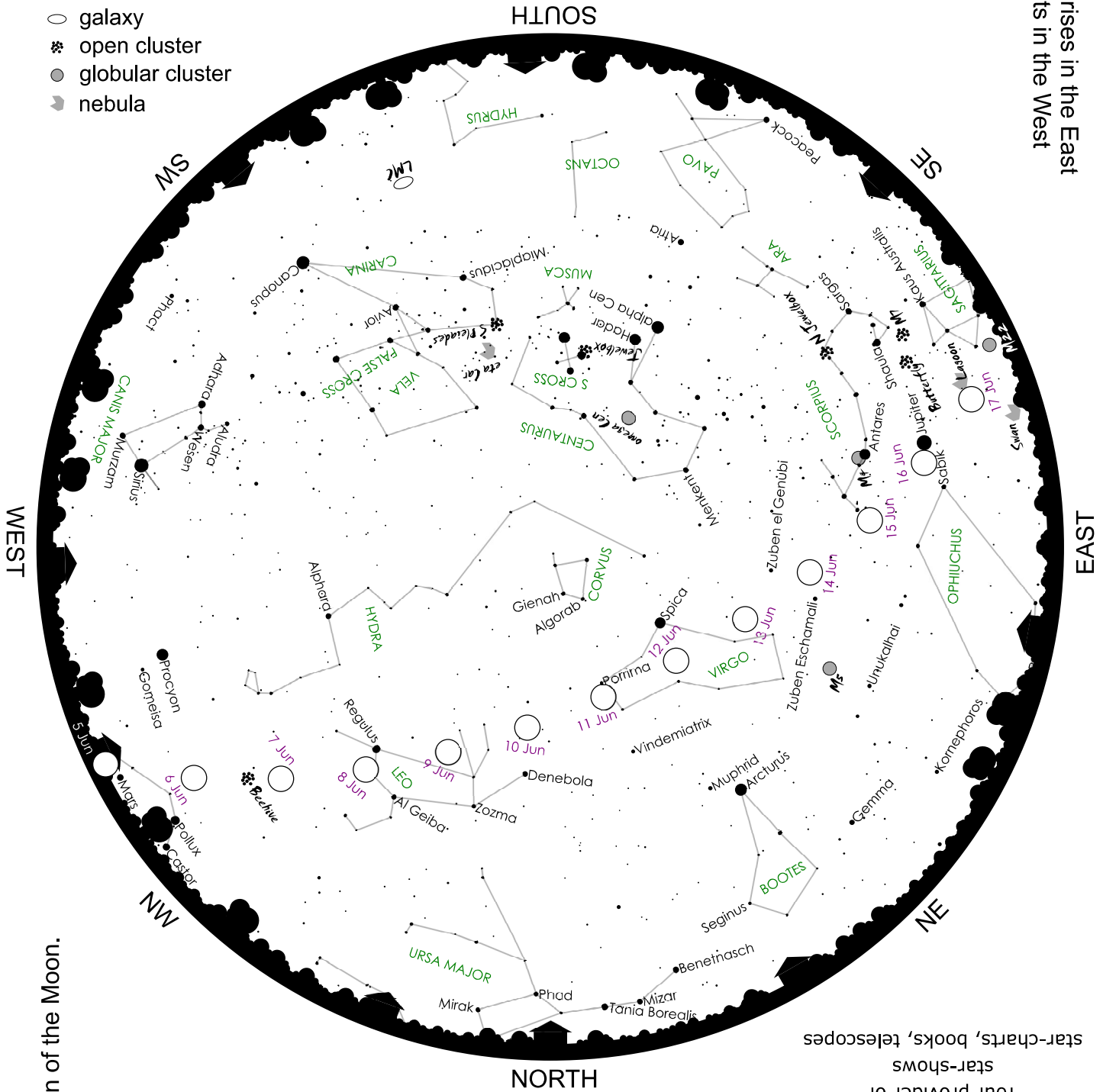
# THE SOUTH AFRICAN EARLY-EVENING SKY EARLY JUNE 2019

To find e.g. stars in the east,  
face east and turn the map  
to put **EAST** at the bottom.

The Sun rises in the East  
and sets in the West

Use binoculars to look for:

- galaxy
- ✳ open cluster
- globular cluster
- ☉ nebula



Circles show the position of the Moon.

The Moon this month:

- Jun 3: new moon
- Jun 10: first quarter
- Jun 17: full moon
- Jun 25: last quarter
